NEW TRAIN FROM DELHI TO KARNATAKA

4025. SHRI B.S. YEDIYURAPPA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Railways has any proposal to introduce new trains from New Delhi to Karnataka in view of heavy traffic;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the time by which new trains to Karnataka from New Delhi are likely to be introduced?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c) Delhi area is presently connected to Bangalore by 09 pair of train services which are adequately catering to the needs of passengers of Karnataka area. At present, there is no proposal to introduce a new train from New Delhi to Karnataka due to operational and resource constraints. However, introduction of trains is an ongoing process over Indian Railways and is done keeping in view the traffic demand, operational feasibility, resource availability, etc.
