- (a) the details of cities that have created Comprehensive Mobility Plans (CMPs) for promoting sustainable transport;
- (b) whether the Government provides any support in the creation of CMPs; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Ministry of Urban Development provides financial assistance of up to 80% for preparation of Comprehensive Mobility Plan (CMP) on the request of the State Governments/Union Territories subject to certain conditions. Twenty five cities viz., Tumkur, Devangere, Shimoga, Agartala, Gangtok, Shillong, Bhatinda, Patiala, Pathankot, Jalandhar, Amirstar, Kalyan-Dombivili, Mangalore, Mysore, Belgaum, Bellary, Gulbarga, Hubli-Dharwar, Jaipur, Tirupati, Bidar, Chitradurga, Bijapur, Hospet and Raichur have prepared CMPs with the financial assistance provided by the Ministry.
