NEW TRAIN FROM DELHI TO JIND VIA SONEPAT-GOHANA

†4048. SHRI RAMESH CHANDER KAUSHIK:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to introduce a new train from Delhi to Jind via Sonapat-Gohana keeping in view the increasing number of passengers;**
- (b) if so, the number of train(s) proposed to be introduced;**
- (c) the time by which the trains are likely to be introduced; and**
- (d) whether there is any proposal to introduce a new train in the Parliamentary Constituency Sonapat to Jind via Gohana to and fro in the morning and evening and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (d) 74019/74020 Jind-Sonapat DEMU (6 days a week) has already been introduced w.e.f. 26.06.2016. At present, there is no proposal to introduce a new train from Delhi to Jind via Sonapat, Gohana due to operational and resource constraints. However, introduction of train is an ongoing process over Indian Railways and is done keeping in view the traffic pattern, operational feasibility, resource availability, etc.
