4049. SHRI HARINARAYAN RAJBHAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the time period within which refund is provided to the passengers holding reserved tickets in the event of cancellation of a train;
- (b) whether there is a difference in time period between e-ticket and the ticket purchased from the counter;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Railways is planning to increase the time period of getting refund of reserved passenger tickets purchased from the counter; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 4049 BY SHRI HARINARAYAN RAJBHAR TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 10.08.2016 REGARDING REFUND FOR E-TICKET AND RAILWAY TICKET PASSENGERS.

(a): As per extant rule, in case of cancellation of trains, automatic refund of fare on confirmed or RAC or Waitlisted e-tickets is directly credited to the account from which booking transactions took place. Online cancellation or filing of TDR is not required in such case. For PRS counter ticket, when the train is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances such as accident, breach or flood, refund of fare is permissible across the counter within three days excluding the scheduled day of departure of the train.

(b)&(c): Comparative important cancellation & Refund rules for PRS counter ticket and e- ticket are as under:

which status of all the passengers is on waiting list after preparation of reservation chart, the refund of fare is directly credited to the account from which booking transaction took place.

(iii) In case of cancellation of trains, or PRS counter ticket, when the train is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances such as accident, breach or flood refund of fare is permissible across the counter within three days excluding the scheduled day of departure of the train.

(iii) In case of cancellation of trains, automatic refund of fare on confirmed or RAC or Waitlisted etickets is directly credited to the account from which booking transactions took place. Online cancellation or filing of TDR is not required in such case
