Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state that the funds allocated under various skill development schemes during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise including Gujarat?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

There are more than 40 schemes being implemented by 20 Ministries/Departments which provide a variety of skill development programmes. During the last three years, i.e., 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16, the number of trained persons (in lakh) is 76.37, 76.11 and 104.16 respectively. The funds under various schemes are released to States in accordance with the Scheme guidelines. There is no central combined database for funds released State-wise under all skill development schemes.

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) is the flagship program for skill development under the Ministry. Under the PMKVY 2015-16, there was no State component for allocation of funds to State Governments. However, in order to address the unique skill requirements of different States, funds are being directly allocated to State Governments including Gujarat State through a project based approach, with 25% of the total training targets, both financial and physical under PMKVY 2016-2020.
