DELHI-BHUSAVAL RAJDHANI TRAIN

4094. SHRI RAMDAS C. TADAS:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government had decided to introduce a Delhi-Bhusawal (*via* Wardha, Nagpur) Rajdhani Express train;**
- (b) if so, the reasons for not introducing the said train so far; and**
- (c) the time by which the said train service is likely to be introduced?**

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

(a) to (c): No, Madam. At present, there is no proposal to introduce a new Rajdhani Express train between Delhi and Bhusawal due to operational and resource constraints. Moreover, Rajdhani Express class of trains are not commuter trains, but are long distance fast moving prestigious trains, primarily meant for connecting National capital and State capitals.
