Will the Minister of LAW AND JUSTICE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware of increasing number of divorce cases in various courts in the country;

(b) if so, the number of such cases pending in these courts as on date in the country, State/UT-wise;

(c) whether the Government is aware that such cases remain pending in courts for a very long period;

(d) if so, whether the Government proposes to formulate any mechanism/scheme for expeditious disposal of such cases; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the other steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regards?

(a) to (e): No data relating to divorce cases is maintained separately. However, a statement giving details of cases pending in Family Courts, State/UT-wise which, inter-alia, includes divorce cases is given in the Annexure. In the Chief Justices Conference, 2015, directions have been issued to all High Courts to regularly monitor and take necessary steps for early disposal of such cases.
