Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has decided to not to take any land/river/sea/soil/coastal erosion projects in the

country during the current Plan; and

(b) if so, the facts thereof and the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION (DR SANJEEV KUMAR BALYAN)

(a) & (b) No, Madam. Flood management being within the purview of States, the schemes for flood control & checking rain water etc are formulated and implemented by concerned States as per their priority. The Union Government supports the efforts of the States by providing technical advice and also promotional financial assistance for management of floods in critical areas. The Government of India had launched Flood Management Programme (FMP for providing central assistance to States for works related to river management , flood control, anti-erosion, drainage development, anti sea erosion, flood proofing works, restoration of damage flood management works, etc. During the XII Plan, a total of 102 flood management projects have been approved under FMP and central assistance of Rs.1207.08 crore has been released till date. The State-wise details of projects approved and funds released in XI and XII Plan till date given at **Annex-1**.

Besides, under Sustainable Coastal Protection and Management Project-Trench-1, two projects namely Ullal coastal Erosion & Inlet Improvement Project in Karnataka and Mirya Bay Coastal Erosion and Protection Project in Maharashtra have been undertaken with a loan from ADB, having financing plan as under:
