- (a) & (b): According to Wholesale Price Index (WPI) data brought out by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP), the prices of wheat flour have increased by 7.57% over the year in June, 2016 as against an increase of 5.54% recorded during May, 2016. No complaints with regard to increase in price of flour by mills have been received by this Department.
- (c) : Government through Food Corporation of India sells wheat at pre-determined prices in the open market from time to time under Open Market Sale Scheme (Domestic) to enhance the supply of wheat especially during the lean season to moderate open market prices in the deficit regions.
