- (a) whether the Union Government proposes to launch a new scheme to provide commercial passenger vehicles in rural areas to revitalize the transport system in all the villages across the country;
- (b) if so, the details of the proposed new scheme and the time by which the said scheme is to be launched;
- (c) whether the said scheme would be launched with cooperation of State Governments/UTs or with villages/ Panchayats directly and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the target fixed for providing vehicles to rural areas during the next two years?

(a) to (d): In order to leverage the rural road network created in the Country, Ministry is contemplating a new scheme i.e. Pradhan Mantri Gram ParivahanYojana (PMGPY) to provide safe, efficient and affordable transport services to the villagers for enhancing access to economic and social opportunities.
