DAUSA-SAWAIMADHOPUR CONNECTED WITH NH

4288. SHRI SUKHBIR SINGH JAUNAPURIA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS  
सड़क परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to connect Dausa-Sawaimadhapur road with the National Highway in Rajasthan;  
(b) if so, the details thereof;  
(c) whether the Government has laid down any time limit for the doubling of this road, if so, the details thereof; and  
(d) whether the Government has increased the budget for the construction of flyovers on NHs, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Dausa-Sawai Madhopur is already connected by National Highway (NH) network via Lalsot, Kothum, Tonk through NH Nos. 148, 23, 52 and 552.

The work of widening to four lane of NH-148 stretch from Dausa to Lalsot and widening to 2 lane with paved shoulders of NH-23 stretch from Lalsot to Kothum have been awarded in July, 2016 with completion period of 30 months from the date of commencement.

NH-52 stretch from Kothum to Tonk is already 4 lane Highway.

The work of widening to 2 lane with paved shoulder of NH-552 stretch from Tonk to Sawai Madhopur has been awarded in August, 2016 with completion period of 24 months from the date of commencement.

(d) The Ministry does not allocate funds separately for construction of flyovers on NHs. The budget allocation for Central Road Sector (Plan) during 2016-17 (Budget Estimate) is as under:-
