NEW HOSPITAL AND MATERNITY CENTRE

4404. SHRI HARISHCHANDRA CHAVAN:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up any new hospital, maternity centre and medical college in Nasik, Maharashtra; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the said hospital and maternity centre are likely to be set up?

(a) & (b): Public Health being a State subject, the primary responsibility to provide quality health care services to the people lies with State/UT Governments. There is no proposal of the central government to set up any new hospital, maternity centre and medical college in Nasik, Maharashtra. However, the central government provides technical and financial assistance to the states, based on proposals of the state government projected in their Programme Implementation Plans (PIP).

In the year 2014-15, Nasik District Hospital, Nasik, Maharashtra was sanctioned 100 bedded MCH wing for provision of quality services to pregnant women and sick infants. The time-line given for completion of such projects in 3 years.

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
