- (a) & (b): Erstwhile Planning Commission approved the two project proposals received from the State Government of Rajasthan under One Time Additional Central Assistance (OTACA) during 2014-15 and recommended the proposals to the Ministry of Finance for the release of funds. NITI Aayog has discontinued the approval of such proposals from 2015-16 following the acceptance of the recommendations of 14th Finance Commission for increased devolution to the States from 32% to 42%. No project proposal from State of Rajasthan is lying pending for approval with NITI Aayog.
