- (a) Yes, Madam. An Expert Committee was constituted by the Ministry of Defence to suggest measures for reducing litigation on 15th July 2015 under the chairmanship of Lt. Gen Mukesh Sabharwal (Retd).
- (b) Yes, Madam.
- (c) The Committee made 75 recommendations relating to ex-servicemen and serving defence and civilian personnel on important matters such as pension, promotion, discipline, vigilance, and military justice & reforms.
- (d) Out of the total 75 recommendations, 16 have been accepted and 16 have been accepted in principle. No final decision has been taken in respect of the remaining recommendations.
