(a): The Government had notified New Investment Policy (NIP) – 2012 on 02<sup>nd</sup> January, 2013 and its amendment on 07<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 to facilitate fresh investment in urea sector and to reduce import dependency. Presently, Department of Fertilizers has received 6 proposals for setting up of Greenfield and Brownfield (Expansion) projects:-

Union Government has also decided to establish following six Brownfield/Revival urea production plants:-

(b) & (c): Yes, Madam. Based on the decision of the CCEA, vide notification dated 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2015, Department of Fertilizers has allowed continuation of production of three naphtha based urea units, i.e. Madras Fertilizers Limited (MFL)- Manali, Southern Petrochemicals Industries Corporation (SPIC) - Tuticorin and Mangalore Chemicals & Fertilizers Limited (MCFL) with Naphtha as feedstock till these plants get assured supply of gas either by pipeline or by any other means.
