- (b) the number of empanelled private hospitals and laboratories under CGHS during the last three years, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) whether some of these empanelled hospitals/laboratories are not providing CGHS rates or cashless treatments to the CGHS beneficiaries, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh; and
- (d) the corrective steps taken by the Government in this regard?

- (a): The number of Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) beneficiaries as on date, city-wise, are at Annexure-I.
- (b): The number of empanelled private hospitals and laboratories under CGHS as on date, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh, are at Annexure-II
- (c): There are some such complaints in respect of some hospitals and diagnostic centres empanelled under CGHS. Details are as under:

- (d): The following steps have been taken by the Government:
  - I. Issue of Show Cause Notice to hospitals/ diagnostic centres against which complaints have been received
- II. Penalty of 15% of the performance Guarantee imposed on hospitals/diagnostic centres on violation of provisions of MoA.
- III. Recovery of excess amount recovered from hospitals and paid to beneficiaries.
- IV. Warning letters issued to erring hospitals/ diagnostic centres.
- V. As per the Memorandum of Agreement signed with hospitals CGHS can inspect hospitals at any time and in the event of repeated defaulters there is a provision for removal of hospitals from CGHS panel.
