REVALUATION OF ANSWER SHEETS OF MEDICAL STUDENTS

4533. SHRIMATI SAVITRI THAKUR:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any provision exists for revaluation of answer sheets/re-counting of marks of medical students at graduate level and also at post-graduation level;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and whether this provision also extended to the courses conducted by the private Colleges/deemed Universities in Madhya Pradesh and Gujarat of the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) As per Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997 of Medical Council of India (MCI), there is no provision for revaluation of answer sheets/re-counting of marks of medical students. However, following provision exists in Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997:-

“The grace marks upto a maximum of five marks may be awarded at the discretion of the University to a student who has failed only in one subject but has passed in all other subjects.”
The MCI’s Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 has no provisions of revaluation of answer sheets of medical students at post-graduation level.
