Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the number of death of women due to tubectomy and the number of deaths of men due to vasectomy during the last three years, State/UT-wise;

(b) the details of incentives given as part of on said sterilisation scheme;

(c) whether sterilisation of women is more complex and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) whether the Government proposes to revise the incentive amounts for sterilisation for encouragement of tubectomy among women and if so, the details thereof and action taken thereon?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a): The number of deaths of women due to tubectomy in the last three years, State/UT wise, is placed at Annexure A. There has been no death of men due to vasectomy during the same period.

(b): The details of incentives given as part of the said sterilization scheme are placed at Annexure B.

(c): Sterilization of women is a surgical procedure which is provided through mainly two modes namely the 'laparoscopic' mode and the 'minilap' mode.
