**STERILISATION SCHEME**

**4536. SHRI PREM DAS RAI:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of death of women due to tubectomy and the number of deaths of men due to vasectomy during the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of incentives given as part of on said sterilisation scheme;
- (c) whether sterilisation of women is more complex and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to revise the incentive amounts for sterilisation for encouragement of tubectomy among women and if so, the details thereof and action taken thereon?

- (a): The number of deaths of women due to tubectomy in the last three years, State/UT wise, is placed at Annexure A. There has been no death of men due to vasectomy during the same period.
- (b): The details of incentives given as part of the said sterilization scheme are placed at Annexure B.
- (c): Sterilization of women is a surgical procedure which is provided through mainly two modes namely the 'laparoscopic' mode and the 'minilap' mode.
