PRODUCTION OF TITANIUM METAL

466. SHRI P. KUMAR:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to start the production of titanium metal and other value added materials from Rare Earths;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the location where the Rare Earth Units are presently functioning in the country and the quantity of products produced from these units?
