(a) & (b) The Government is implementing the “Khelo India – National Programme for development of Sports” Scheme from the current financial year 2016-17. The Scheme inter-alia provides for creation of the following sports infrastructure :

S. No.	Particulars	At District/State level
1.	Synthetic Athletic Track	Rs. 7.00 crore
2.	Synthetic Hockey field	Rs. 5.50 crore
3.	Synthetic turf football ground	Rs. 5.00 crore

4.	Multipurpose Hall of size 60M x 40M x 12.5M	Rs. 8.00 crore
5.	Swimming Pool	Rs.5.00 crore
6.	Construction of Stadia complex at District Hqs.	Rs.50.00 crore

Among others, Schools, colleges and Universities under Central and State Governments are eligible to receive funds under this Scheme for the purpose.
