WATER THROUGH TAPS/HANDPUMPS AT STATIONS

†481. SHRI SATYAPAL SINGH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has chalked out any special plan to provide water through taps/handpumps at railway stations during summer and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether there is any proposal to install water coollers at every station during summer and if so, the details thereof?

- (a): It is Railways' endeavour to provide potable drinking water at all stations through taps/hand-pumps as per norms. During summer season, when there is a water scarcity and existing sources are found inadequate to meet the water requirements at the stations, water supply is made through tankers.
- (b): No, Madam. However, as per extant policy guidelines of Railway Board, water coolers are to be provided on those stations which deal with 1000 passengers or more (inward and outward) per day, on the average, and water coolers are accordingly provided.
