BIO-TECHNOLOGY PARKS

- (a) the details of present bio-technology parks operating in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has allocated funds for establishment of bio-technology parks in each State;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to establish more bio-technology parks in the country; and
- (e) if so, the places identified for this purpose and the steps being taken by Government in this regard?

(a) The details of present bio-technology parks operating in the country State/UT-wise with the financial assistance from by the Department of Biotechnology are as follows:-

- i) Uttar Pradesh – The Lucknow Bio-Technology Park has been established a Lucknow with the support from the Department of Biotechnology. It has started its operations since the year 2006.
- ii) Telangana - The Hyderabad Bio-Technology Park has been established by CSIR-IICT and Government of Andhra Pradesh with financial support from the Department of Biotechnology. It has stated its operations since 2009.

Tamil Nadu – (a) TICEL Bio-Technology Park, Chennai was established by Government of Tamil Nadu in Chennai and is in operation since November, 2004. The Department of Biotechnology had sanctioned grant for establishing a Biotechnology Core Instrumentation Facility (BTCIF) in the Park; (b) Golden Jubilee Bio-Tech Park for Women (Siruseri, Kanchipuram District) was established by the Government of Tamil Nadu with support from the Department of Biotechnology and is in operation since 2001.
