#### MUD PACK THERAPY ON TAJ MAHAL

## 52. SHRI SATAV RAJEEV: SHRI DHANANJAY MAHADIK :

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether mud pack therapy has been used frequently on the Taj Mahal;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for this move;
- (c) the amount of expenditure incurred on this therapy;
- (d) whether frequent use of mud pack therapy is adversely affecting monuments' aesthetic value; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the corrective steps taken by the Government to protect the monument?

### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE, CULTURE AND TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) The mud pack method is considered most appropriate for cleaning of marble
- & surface. It has not been used frequently, as once cleaned the surface does not
- (b) require treatment for about 6-7 years.
- (c) The year-wise details of expenditure incurred for cleaning of marble surface of Taj Mahal, during last three years are as follows:-

(d) No Madam. The mud pack treatment improves the aesthetic value of the monument by removal of engrained accretionary deposits.
