- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up Railway Ticket Reservation Centres at certain places of pilgrimage like Golden Temple (Punjab), Shirdi Sai Temple (Maharashtra), Badridham Temple(Uttarakhand), Mahakaleshwar Temple (Madhya Pradesh);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (c): Railway Ticket Reservation Centres are functioning at about 3380 locations including pilgrimage centres. The computerised reservation centres are provided based on technical feasibility and commercial justification as per policy at stations, at District Headquarters, important hill stations/tourist & pilgrimage centres/post offices on the basis of proposals received from public/public representatives and the zonal Railways.
