(a) to (c) The Department of Electronics and IT is the nodal Ministry for spreading digital literacy in the Country. As far this Ministry is concerned, efforts have been made to use technology for bettering standards of education through the National Mission on Education through Information & Communication Technology (NMEICT). Under this, IIT Bombay has undertaken and completed the Aakash-II project, under which Low Cost Access Device (LCAD) was developed with open source operating system and these devices have been provided to 1 lakh students and teachers in 336 institutions across the country. This Ministry, working along with the National Knowledge Network (NKN), has provided high-speed broadband connectivity to (438) Universities / Institutes and 22,029 Colleges including Polytechnics.
