Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish more Kendriya Vidyalayas in all the States, particularly in Chikmagalur and Mysore districts of Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which such schools are likely to start operating, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Proposals for opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India or State Governments / Union Territories Administrations or Organization of employees belonging to the eligible categories thereby committing resources including land for setting up a new KV, and are subject to availability of resources with the Central Government. The Government of India had conveyed sanction for setting up of 54 new KVs in the country on 4.3.2014 including 5 in Karnataka. Out of these, 40 KVs have been made functional on fulfillment of the prescribed norms including the 5 KVs sanctioned in the State of Karnataka, at (i) Mandya (ii) Chamarajanagar, (iii) Haveri, (iv) Chikodi (District Belgaum) and (v) Udupi. At present there is no decision for establishment of new KVs in Chikmagalur and Mysore districts of Karnataka.
