CLEARANCES TO RAILWAY PROJECTS

624. SHRI BHARTRUHARI MAHTAB: SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE: SHRI RAHUL SHEWALE:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of railway projects stalled due to lack of clearances from the department of environment/forest along with the amount stuck therein across the country, as on date, Zone/State/Union territory-wise;
- (b) whether the Railways have suffered losses on account of being dormant in earning revenue from such projects and their cost escalation over a period of time;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, project-wise and the reasons therefor along with the reaction of the Railways thereto;
- (d) whether the Railways did not obtain prior clearances from the department of environment/forest for these projects; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 624 BY SHRI BHARTRUHARI MAHTAB, SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE AND SHRI RAHUL SHEWALE TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 20.07.2016 REGARDING CLEARANCES TO RAILWAY PROJECTS

(a) to (c): Clearances from different land owning agencies, acquisition of land, shifting of services/utilities are part of project execution and these activities are bound to take some time. However, following projects have suffered due to non availability of forest clearances.

Working out cost escalation or revenue loss on account of delay in forest clearance alone is not feasible to be worked out.

(d) & (e): Railway being one of the most environment friendly means of transport does not require environment clearance for undertaking projects. Proposal for diversion of forest land and tree cutting, wherever needed, can only be prepared only after detailed survey, pegging of alignment and preparation of land schedule.
