631. DR. K. KAMARAJ:

Will the Minister of Electronics & Information technology be pleased to state: -

- (a) the number of registered Information Technology (IT) companies functioning in the country as on date, State-wise;
- (b) whether more than 50% of the companies working in the field of IT sector are not registered;
- (c) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (d) whether revenue loss as a result thereof to the exchequer has been assessed; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a): As per the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA), Government of India, the number of registered IT Companies functioning in the country as on 30.06.2016 is 95,084. The State/UT wise list of Registered IT Companies is given in Annexure.

(b): As per the MCA, information of companies working in the field of IT sector not registered with Registrar of Companies is not maintained.
