Last survey of National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) on Employment-Unemployment was conducted during July, 2011 – June, 2012 (68th round of NSS). However, to assess the effect of economic slowdown on employment in India, Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour & Employment, has been conducting Quarterly Quick Employment surveys in selected labour-intensive and export-oriented sectors, namely, textiles including apparels, leather, metals, automobiles, gems & jewellery, transport, IT/BPO and handloom/powerloom. Based on the latest available results from these surveys, the estimated net addition of jobs during each of the last three years is given at Annexure.
