Financial Grants to NSFs

665. SHRI RAVNEET SINGH:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the financial grants provided by the Central Government to the National Sports Federations (NSFs) in India during the last two years;
- (b) whether the Government will bring the Sports Development Bill, 2011 for consideration of the House; and
- (c) if so, the time by which it is anticipated and the details along with the salient features thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS (SHRI VIJAY GOEL)

(a) Details of financial grant provided during the last two years to various National Sports Federations (NSFs) and some other organisations are given in the annexure.

(b) & (c) The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has formulated a draft National Sports Development Bill (NSDB). The salient features of the NSDB are:

• Central Government support for development and promotion of sports.

- Promotion of ethical practices in sports.
- Rights and obligations of the Indian Olympic Association and National Sports Federations.
- Participation of athletes in the management/decision making of the NSFs and the Indian Olympic Association.
- Mechanism for sports dispute settlement.
- Bringing National Sports Federations under Right to Information Act, 2005 with certain exclusion clauses for protecting personal/confidential information relating to athletes.
- Age and tenure restrictions for office-bearers of NSFs.

Since further consultations are required, it would be difficult to indicate a definite time frame for bringing it for consideration of the House.
