Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of benefits that might accrue to India by becoming a member of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO); and
- (b) whether there is proposal for military and diplomatic engagement with other member States of the SCO and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) India's membership of SCO will provide opportunities for cooperation on economic and security matters including counterterrorism. SCO also has potential to enhance connectivity options and energy security for India.
- (b) India has diplomatic relations with all the SCO member countries. SCO has regular discussions on wide range of issues. It also organizes joint anti-terrorist exercises and facilitates sharing of information and best practices on combating terrorism.
