Will the Minister of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to set up Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the North Eastern Region in the current financial year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, location-wise;
- (c) whether the Ministry has any specific plan to establish ITIs in the rural areas of Assam including the tea garden areas to arrest the problem of growing unemployment in these areas and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to establish an ITI in every block and district of the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has formulated a scheme titled "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States & Sikkim" to set up 22 new Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the North Eastern Region.
- (b) The details along with location are at **Annex-I**.
- (c) Out of the 22 new ITIs, five ITIs have been allocated to the State of Assam. The location of such ITIs may be seen at **Annex-I**.
- (d) & (e) Another scheme titled "Setting up of 1500 Multi Skill Training Institutes (MSTIs) in unserved blocks/areas with active participation of Industry/ private sector partner" is under formulation. Meeting of the Expenditure Finance Committee for considering the above proposal for the scheme was held on 19th April, 2016. Cabinet Note is under preparation. Once the scheme is approved, it will be implemented expeditiously.
