- (a) whether the Government has identified 10 iconic places with higher footfalls including Taj Mahal and Vaishno Devi to be cleaned on part with international standards and if so, the details thereof and the expenditure likely to be incurred in each place;
- (b) whether the World Bank will provide technical assistance for this purpose and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is also in the process of drafting a Standard Operating Procedure to ensure cleanliness at many sanctuaries and tiger reserves and other places identified by the Government, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the time by which the work is likely to be started and completed; and
- (e) the other steps taken/being taken to clean all the iconic places of the country?

All the Stakeholders, who are responsible for upkeep of these iconic place that includes the Local Administration, Tourism Department, Archaeological Survey of India etc. has been advise to prepared their plan along with expenditure to be incurred and sources/schemes from where the funds are to be dovetailed.
- (b) Technical Experts from World Banks were called for the workshop held on 8-9th July 2016 to provide support in preparing the proposed Action Plan.
