SETTING UP OF MRO FACILITIES

- (a) whether there is any proposal for establishing Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) facilities at various airports of the country, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether the small and big aircraft of the country and other countries are able to use MRO facility established in the country, if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether Pawan Hans Limited and Hindustan Aeronautics Limited have inked a deal to set up MRO facility for defence and civil helicopters, if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) whether the fleet size of helicopters in civil segment is estimated to go upto 800 from 280 in the next 10-15 years and if so, the details thereof ?**

(a): At present there is no proposal pending with the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) for establishing Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) facilities at any airports of the country.

(b): The small and large aircraft of the country are able to use MRO facilities established in the country.

MRO's approved for maintenance of large aircraft are:-

- i) Air India Engineering Services Limited (AIESL), Delhi**
- ii) Jet Airways (India) Limited, Mumbai**
- iii) MAS GMR Aero Technic Limited, Hyderabad**
- iv) Airworks India Limited, Hosur (Tamil Nadu)**
- v) Cochin International Airport Limited (CIAL), Cochin**

MRO's approved for maintenance of small aircraft including helicopters are:-

- i) Airworks India Engineering, Mumbai**
- ii) Shaurya Aeronautics Private Limited, Delhi**
- iii) Indamer Aviation Private Limited, Mumbai**
- iv) Pawan Hans Limited, Mumbai**
- v) Global Vectra Helicorp Limited, Mumbai**
- vi) Indocopter Private Limited, Delhi**

As regards maintenance of aircrafts of foreign airlines, M/s CIAL, Cochin is carrying out the line maintenance for Tiger Airways, Srilankan Airlines, Qatar Airways etc.

(c): Yes, Pawan Hans Limited (PHL) has signed an Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 16.03.2016 with Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) for development of MRO facilities initially to serve defence customers for ALH Dhruv Type of Helicopters with progressive addition of Civil and other Helicopter Types in the MRO facilities.

(d): No such assessment has been conducted.
