PASSENGERS WITH FAKE TICKETS AT DELHI AIRPORT

- (a) whether more than 30 men were caught entering Delhi airport with fake tickets in just 14 months;
(b) if so, the details thereof;
(c) whether the CISF has demanded that PNR readers need to be installed at the gate to check illegal entry; and
(d) if so, the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): Yes Madam. During the last 14 months CISF have detected 34 cases of persons gaining entry into the terminal building at IGI airport, Delhi. The persons caught were handed over to Delhi Police for further legal action in the matter.

(c) & (d): Yes Madam. CISF have requested for uniform format in e-tickets together with bar coding on the same and bar code reader at departure entry gates to prevent use of fake e-tickets. Further, Bureau of Civil Aviation have issued instructions to the airport operators to install 2 D bar code scanner.
