VENDOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Vendor Development Programmes (VDPs) conducted by the Government at National and State level along with the outcome thereof during each of the last three years;
- (b) the details of the vendors registered by the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) in a cumulative way during the said period;
- (c) the details of the initiative taken by the leading PSUs in the country under the VDPs programme; and
- (d) the details of the targets fixed and achieved under the programme during the said period?

(a): MSME Development Institutes have conducted 158 National Level Vendor Development Programmes (NVDPs) and 863 State Level Vendor Development Programmes (SVDPs) during the last three years i.e. 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16. 61,747 Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) were benefitted by participating in these programmes.

(b) & (c): The Vendor Development Programme is organized to create awareness among the MSMEs about the procurement needs of the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and their registration procedure. The aim of organizing these programmes by the PSUs among others is to provide common platform for competitive procurement from MSMEs and also to increase their vendor base by providing appropriate market linkages.

(d): The details of targets fixed and achieved under the programme during the last three years are detailed below:
