Will the Minister of DEFENCE j{kk ea=h be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is shortage of pilots in the Indian Air Force (IAF);

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has taken steps to develop sufficient infrastructure for training of pilots to fill the shortage gap;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) if not, the steps taken by the Government to meet the shortage?

(a) & (b): The available strength of pilots in Air Force is sufficient to meet the current operational requirements of the Indian Air Force (IAF). The strength of pilots as on 1^{st} July, 2016 is 3874 against the sanctioned strength of 4062.

(c) to (e): A comprehensive roadmap to increase training capacity for abinitio training in IAF is already in place. Development of infrastructure for training purpose based on the requirement of Indian Air Force is a continuous process.
