SERVICES AT AAMSs IN KARNATAKA

Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the range of services including teleconsultation, being provided at operational Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) under the Ayushman Bharat Programme in Karnataka, district-wise;
- (b) the details of funds allocated, released and utilised for AAMs in the State during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to strengthen AAMs in the State under the PM-Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission, if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has undertaken any review of the operational status of AAMs in the States of Karnataka and Himachal Pradesh, if so, the details and the outcome thereof; and
- (e) whether any gaps relating to infrastructure, manpower or service delivery have been identified in the functioning of AAMs in these States, if so, the corrective measures taken thereon?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO. 200* FOR 31TH JULY, 2026**

(a) to (e) Public Health & hospitals fall under the State list and therefore, the primary responsibility of strengthening public healthcare system is with the States/Union Territories. However, under the National Health Mission (NHM), the Government of India supports all States/Union Territories. States/Union Territories submit their proposals through the annual Programme Implementation Plan (PIP), and based on the available resource envelope (RE), the Government of India grants approvals in the Record of Proceedings (RoPs) as per the approved norms and guidelines.

As updated by the States/Union Territories on Ayushman Arogya Mandir (AAM) portal, as on 30.06.2026, a total of 1,86,298 Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) have been established and operationalized in the country including 10,137 AAMs in Karnataka. The district-wise details of AAMs in Karnataka is at **Annexure-I**.

The Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) are required to deliver 12 packages of primary health care services across urban, rural, tribal dominated and aspirational district areas, encompassing Reproductive and Child Care Services, Communicable Diseases, Non Communicable Diseases, Palliative Care and Elderly Care, Care for Common Mental Disorders, Substance Use Disorders Management, Oral Health, ENT Care and Basic Emergency Care and Tele-consultations.

As informed by State of Karnataka, the details of funds released and expenditure under National Health Mission (NHM) for Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (AAMs) during the last three financial years viz. from 2023-24 to 2025-26 are as under:

Further, Under CSS component of Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM), Administrative approval has been accorded to the State of Karnataka for an amount of Rs. 1928.79 Cr. for construction of 530 Building less Sub-Health Centres- AAMs (SHC-AAMs), establishment and strengthening of 817 Urban-AAMs (U-AAMs), as proposed by the state. As per information provided by the State, the district-wise details of the sanctioned SHC-AAMs and U-AAMs are at **Annexure-II**.

Under NHM, the performance of various health programmes implemented in States/ Union Territories including Ayushman Arogya Mandirs is regularly assessed in the country including Karnataka and Himachal Pradesh through review meetings, mid-term reviews of key deliverables, field visits of senior officials, promoting performance by setting up benchmarks for service delivery & rewarding achievements etc. Common Review Missions (CRM) are conducted annually to assess and monitor the progress and implementation status of various schemes.
