- (b) the number of faculty members, doctors and staff currently posted against the sanctioned posts; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Union Government to provide better OPD services and healthcare facilities to patients from North-Bengal and neighbouring districts?

- (a): Out of total 16 super-speciality departments in All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Kalyani, 15 super-speciality departments are functional.
- (b): The status of sanctioned, filled and vacant faculty and non-faculty positions in AIIMS Kalyani is as under:

- (c): AIIMS Kalyani has undertaken several patient-centric initiatives to improve access, reduce waiting time, and facilitate seamless outpatient services for patients. These initiatives include expansion of Out-Patient Department (OPD) services, increase in patient registration capacity, online appointment system, implementation of Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM)-enabled Digital Health Services, swasthya mobile application, same-day-investigation, expansion of diagnostic facilities, integrated specialist care, cashless treatment under Government Schemes etc.
