Construction of Hostels in Navodaya Vidyalayas

1290. Shri Rambhual Nishad:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of construction of hostels in Navodaya Vidyalayas started in the country during the last three years, State/UT-wise and year-wise especially district-wise in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the status of construction of hostel in Navodaya Vidyalaya at Sultanpur district of Uttar Pradesh as on date;
- (c) whether the construction of the said hostel at Sultanpur has been completed, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons for delay; and
- (d) the time by which the said construction is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The construction of permanent NavodayaVidyalaya (NV) building including hostels is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of lease formalities in favour of NavodayaVidyalayaSamiti (NVS) by the sponsoring authorities, submission of drawings/estimates by construction agency, availability of funds and requisite approvals, etc. as well as consecutive growth of the Vidyalaya.

NVs are constructed in three phases, i.e. Phase-A, Phase-B and Phase-B (balance) as per growth of the students and efficient use of infrastructures. Under Phase A - School Building, Kitchen Dining, partial dormitories & partial staff quarters are constructed. Under Phase B - partial dormitories & staff quarters and in Phase B (balance) - left over dormitories are constructed as per actual requirement basis. As per information received from NVS, in Uttar Pradesh, hostel/ dormitories(beds) had been constructed in the year 2023-24 in NVs in Kanshiramnagar (192 beds), Hapur (384 beds), Shamli (192 beds), Badaun (192 beds) and Sultanpur (288 beds) districts. During the year 2025-26, construction of hostel/dormitories(beds) has been started in NVs in GB Nagar (24 beds) and Sitapur-I (48 beds). Further, State/UT-wise details of NVs including in the State of Uttar Pradesh where construction of hostels/dormitories (beds) have been started/completed during the last three years in the country are at Annexed.
