UNIVERSAL COVERAGE UNDER JJM

1962. SHRI RAMASAHAYAM RAGHURAM REDDY:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether all rural households have been provided Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTCs) under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) if not, the details of uncovered households, State-wise; and
- (c) the expected timeline for achieving universal coverage under the mission?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Since August 2019, Government of India, in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)-Har Ghar Jal to enable every rural household in the country to have assured potable water through tap connection at a service level of 55 litre per capita per day (LPCD), of prescribed quality (BIS:10500), on regular and long-term basis. The Union Cabinet has approved the extension of the JJM 2.0 by December, 2028 with an enhanced outlay and a restructured implementation framework focusing on structural reforms in rural drinking water supply sector.

Drinking water is a State subject, and hence, the responsibility of planning, approval, implementation, operation, and maintenance of drinking water supply schemes, including those under the Jal Jeevan Mission, lies with the respective State/UT Governments. The Government of India supports the States by providing technical and financial assistance only.

At the start of the Mission, only 3.24 crore (16.72%) rural households were reported to have tap water connection in the country. As on 18.07.2026, out of 19.36 crore rural households, around 15.89 crore (82.09%) rural households have been provided tap water connection.
