IMPLEMENTATION OF DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES IN TRIBAL AREAS

Will the Minister of Tribal Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has carried out any assessment of the implementation and impact of Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM JANMAN), Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) and other tribal development programmes;

(b) if so, the details and the present status of the works approved, completed, funds utilized and the tribal families benefitted from the said schemes in Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh, district-wise;

(c) the measures taken by the Government to strengthen convergence between various Ministries of the Union Government and the State Governments for effective implementation of tribal development schemes including schemes related to drinking water, roads, power supply, health services, education facilities, mobile and internet connectivity and skill-development;

(d) the initiatives taken to strengthen the availability of basic services and livelihood opportunities in tribal areas particularly in Chhattisgarh, district-wise; and

(e) whether the Government proposes to implement any new scheme or package for the overall and sustainable development of remote and tribal dominated villages of Madhya Pradesh and if so, the details thereof, district-wise?

(a): NITI Aayog (DMEO) has conducted an Evaluation Study of Centrally Sponsored Schemes under Package 9, analysing their performance during the period FY 2020–21 to FY 2024–25 which covered the following Centrally Sponsored schemes under Vanbandhu Kalyan Yojana:

1. Pre-Matric Scholarship
2. Post Matric Scholarship for STs
3. Support to Tribal Research Institutes
4. Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs)
5. Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN)
6. Pradhan Mantri Adi Adrash Gram Yojna – PMAAGY (previously known as Special Central Assistance to Tribal Sub-Scheme - SCA to TSS). PMAAGY is now revamped and is subsumed under DAJGUA
7. Administrative Cost to States / UTs

The Ministry has also undertaken evaluation of the following Central Sector schemes:

1. Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS)
2. National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students
3. Scholarship to the ST Students for studies abroad
4. Aid to Voluntary Organizations working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes
5. Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Vikas Mission (PMJVM)
6. Tribal Research Information, Education, Communication and Events (TRI-ECE)
7. Monitoring, Evaluation, Survey and Social Audit (MESSA)
8. Venture Capital Fund for Scheduled Tribes

DAJGUA was launched on 2nd October, 2024 and is presently under implementation. As the programme is at a relatively mid stage, no separate impact assessment has been undertaken so far. However, implementation of the interventions under the Abhiyan is being regularly monitored through periodic reviews with concerned Ministries/Departments, States/UTs and other stakeholders.

(b), (d) & (e): Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM JANMAN) and Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DA JGUA) comprehensively target development of tribal / PVTG population in accordance with the approved norms. These abhiyans aim to provide basic facilities to improve socio-economic conditions of tribals / PVTGs such as safe housing, clean drinking water and improved access to education, health and nutrition, road and telecom connectivity, electrification of unelectrified households and sustainable livelihood opportunities.

The details of the benefits given under PM JANMAN, as on 30.06.2026, Ministry-wise and District-wise in Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh, are given at **Annexure I**. The financial progress under PM JANMAN for interventions of Ministry of Tribal Affairs in respect of State of Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh is given at **Annexure II**.

The details of the projects and financial progress under DA JGUA by Ministry of Tribal Affairs in Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh are given at **Annexure III**.

(c): The Ministry is regularly coordinating with concerned line Ministries/Departments / State Tribal Welfare Department / other line State Departments for implementation of the existing interventions under the PM JANMAN, DA JGUA and other tribal development schemes to expedite the progress and achievements.
