Student Dropouts during Transition Stages

2465. Shri Kunduru Raghuvver:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any assessment on the number of students discontinuing education while transitioning from the Foundational to Preparatory, Preparatory to Middle and Middle to Secondary stages under the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020;
- (b) if so, the details of such students during the last five years, State/UT-wise, gender-wise and social category-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has identified the major reasons for such dropouts, including non-availability of schools offering higher classes in the same village, long travel distances, lack of transport, financial hardship and other socio-economic factors, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has identified districts with higher dropout rates during these transitions, if so, the details thereof along with the corrective measures proposed to be taken by the Government; and
- (e) the measures taken or proposed to ensure seamless transition between stages of school education and prevent students, particularly those from rural, tribal and economically weaker sections, from discontinuing their education?

(a) and (b): As per Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+), State/UT wise and gender wise the dropout rate and transition rate during 2022-23 to 2025-26 at various educational stages are available at annexure-I:

(c): As per report titled 'Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS)' for the year 2025 released by Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), the major reasons for the students who never attended the schools are to supplement household income, to attend domestic chores, etc.

(d) and (e): Education is in the concurrent list of the Constitution and majority of the schools are under the domain of respective State and UT Governments. The Central Government assist States and UTs through the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Samagra Shiksha and hot cooked meal provided from Balvatika to class 8 under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN) Yojna. Financial assistance/grant is also provided to the States and UTs for various activities to reduce dropout and increase enrolment in Government schools, which include opening/strengthening of new schools up to Senior Secondary level, strengthening school infrastructure, setting up and up gradation and running of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBV) upto class 12, setting up of residential schools/hostels named Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas, hostels under Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN) and Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA), transport allowance, undertaking enrolment drives, seasonal hostels/residential camps, provision of vocational education and ICT facilities in schools, providing free text books and free uniform, transport/escort facility, etc.

Government has also taken initiatives such as Vidya Samiksha Kendra (VSK) and implementation of Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry (APAAR) ID to monitor the drop out and other education indicators. VSK has been developed with strategies designed to enhance the effectiveness of monitoring of educational initiatives and their eventual outcomes. A key feature of VSK is student tracking to prevent dropouts, monitoring of students migrating from one school to the other, progress of learning outcomes and real-time monitoring of various interventions, aimed at improving access, students' academic performance and enhancing teachers' accountability in schools. APAAR, as part of the 'One Nation, One Student ID' programme, is a 12-digit lifelong student ID that is linked to Aadhar
