PM GATI SHAKTI NATIONAL MASTER PLAN

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has prepared or is implementing any integrated development strategy or master plan for Warangal district under PM Gati Shakti – National Master Plan, the Aspirational Blocks Programme or any other flagship initiative of the Government;
- (b) if so, the details of projects identified, sanctioned and under implementation, along with the details of financial assistance sanctioned, released and utilised, year-wise; and
- (c) the expected socio-economic impact of these initiatives on Warangal Lok Sabha Constituency particularly with regard to infrastructure development, employment generation, industrial growth, logistics connectivity and improvement in public service delivery?

- (a) & (b):** PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS-NMP) initiative, launched in October 2021, is a transformative approach for planning and development of infrastructure in the country. Central Ministries and State/UTs are using PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS-NMP) - a geospatial digital platform - for planning of their respective infrastructure projects, including the social infrastructure projects such as schools, hospital, anganwadis etc. As on date, 58 Central Ministries/Departments and all 36 States/UTs have been onboarded on PMGS-NMP. The State of Telangana is also a part of this initiative and using this platform for mapping of its relevant GIS data layers and planning of projects including those in Warangal district.

Different Ministries/Departments are using this platform for data driven decision making and planning of projects under different flagship initiatives such as Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Jal Jeevan Mission, Swachh Bharat Mission, Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adiwasi Nyaya Maha AbhiyaN (PM-JANMAN), Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DA-JGUA) etc.

Aspirational District programme and Aspirational Block programme have also been integrated with PMGS-NMP - Warangal district has no aspirational block as on date.

The Network Planning Group (NPG), constituted under the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan (PMGS-NMP) framework, evaluates the critical infrastructure projects of the central Government to ensure integrated planning, multi-modality, inter-modality, synchronization of efforts, last mile connectivity, comprehensive development in and around the project location, data driven decision makings, etc at the planning stage. As on date, 23 projects falling fully or partially in the State of Telangana have been evaluated by NPG which benefits connectivity to Warangal district and one of these, i.e. a road project related to Ministry of Road Transport and Highways is passing through Warangal district.

Further, 03 Rail connectivity projects of about 447 km, costing about ₹ 7843 Crore and 04 National Highway projects of about 185 km, costing about ₹6,133 Crore have been sanctioned to improve the connectivity in Warangal district.

Moreover, Under the PM MITRA Scheme, a Brownfield Textile Park has been inaugurated at Warangal over 1,327 acres with a project cost of about ₹1,696 crore.

(c): Expected Socio-Economic impacts of the above initiatives of the Government are as under:

- The PMGS NMP is facilitating Ministries/States in planning of their respective infrastructure projects, including social infrastructure projects, in integrated, synchronized and coordinated manner to provide seamless and efficient connectivity for the movement of people, goods, and services across various modes of transport, thereby enhancing last-mile connectivity and reducing travel time. PMGS NMP is also helping in improvement in ease of doing business through better site selection, reduced delays, and enhanced transparency.
- PM MITRA Park offers excellent multimodal connectivity to major railway networks and seaports, ensuring seamless logistics for global trade. The Park is expected to have a significant socio-economic impact on the Warangal area by promoting industrial growth, strengthening logistics connectivity, creating employment opportunities, and developing world class integrated textile infrastructure.
- Reduction in Freight-related traffic congestion, particularly in the historic core areas of Warangal.
- Improvement in urban living through efficient, safe and sustainable freight movement.
- Enhanced local economic development by improving logistic efficiency and reducing logistics costs.
