Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is considering to build 74 additional land ports along the International Border, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether it is a fact that the new land ports proposed are expected to strengthen trade and seamless movement of people with the neighbouring countries; and

(c) whether it is also a fact that the proposed 74 new land ports will be executed phase-wise and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): Land Ports are developed with the aim to facilitate trade and passenger movement across the International land borders. Development of Land Ports at designated points depends upon volume of trade and passenger movement, existence of mirror facilities and geopolitical conditions in the neighboring countries.
