- (b) the details of the financial assistance released by the Government for MSME development during the last three years in Rajasthan including Churu and Hanumangarh districts;
- (c) the number of employment opportunities generated through MSMEs in Churu and Hanumangarh districts during the said period; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to promote MSME growth and local employment generation in Churu and Hanumangarh districts
