- (a) the details of approved Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) value at Tamil Nadu's Global Investors Meet versus the actual realised FDI equity inflow into the State from Financial Year 2020-21;
- (b) the break-up of MoUs that have not progressed to implementation, and the reasons cited by investors, where known, sector-wise;
- (c) whether the Centre's own investment-facilitation agencies have identified any Central-level bottleneck contributing to this gap, as distinct from State-level factors;
- (d) the total number and list of foreign companies that have invested in Tamil Nadu from financial Year 2020-21 to date, along with the total yearly Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) inflows received by the State;
- (e) the percentage share of India's total FDI received by Tamil Nadu since 2020-21, year and State-wise during the said period and the manner in which this compares with the percentage of FDI received by all other States, State-wise during the said period including Gujarat and Karnataka; and
- (f) the details of FDI inflows during the last five years, State, industry and year-wise?

- (a) to (f):** The Government of India supplements the efforts of all States/UTs through various measures to enhance commercial activity in the country and provides an enabling ecosystem for the overall industrial development of the country through appropriate policy interventions. In addition to on-going schemes of other Ministries/ Departments, the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade has taken various steps/initiatives for promotion and facilitation

of industries across States/UTs, such as Make in India, Start-up India, PM GatiShakti, National Industrial Corridor Programme, Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme, promoting Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) & reducing compliance burden, National Single Window System (NSWS), India Industrial Land Bank, Project Monitoring Group (PMG), liberalization of FDI policy, Indian Footwear and Leather Development Programme (IFLDP) Scheme, etc.

The details of approved MoU value at Tamil Nadu's Global Investors Meet and the actual realised FDI equity inflow into the State is at **Annexure-I**. The break-up of MoUs that have not progressed to implementation, along with the reasons cited by investors, where known, sector-wise is at **Annexure-II**.
