PROGRESS ACHIEVED UNDER SWADESH DARSHAN SCHEME

3612. SHRI THARANIVENTHAN M S:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of progress achieved under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme (SDS) during the last five years, including the number of projects sanctioned, completed and pending, State / UT-wise including Arani Lok Sabha Constituency of Tamil Nadu;**
- (b) the details of funds allocated, released and utilised under the scheme during the said period, along with the details of tourist circuits covered;**
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any assessment of the impact of the scheme on tourism infrastructure development, tourist footfall, employment generation and local economic growth and if so, the details thereof;**
- (d) the details of reasons for delays, if any, in completion of sanctioned projects and the steps taken to ensure timely implementation, quality monitoring and effective utilisation of funds; and**
- (e) whether the Government proposes to expand the scope of the Swadesh Darshan Scheme by including more destinations, heritage sites, rural tourism locations and lesser-known tourist attractions and if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) to (e): The Ministry had launched the Swadesh Darshan Scheme (SDS) in 2014-15 for integrated development of tourism infrastructure under 15 identified thematic circuits. Under the Scheme, 76 projects have been sanctioned across different States with a total sanctioned cost of ₹5295.24

crore and have been implemented in accordance with the scheme guidelines. 75 projects out of 76 sanctioned projects are reported physically complete.

The Ministry regularly encourages State Governments/ UT Administrations to engage with local communities and to ensure robust operation & management (O&M) of completed projects so as to increase footfall, generate local employment and enhance overall tourist satisfaction.

Ministry of Tourism regularly monitors progress of its ongoing projects through review meetings with SGs/UTAs, which are held at various levels from time to time. Ministry of Tourism has also developed a Program Management Information System (PMIS) which is a unified digital platform to facilitate seamless information communication, sharing and reporting system in respect of the projects undertaken as parts of Ministry's various schemes. Ministry of Tourism and SGs/UTAs including project implementing agencies are integral part of this system.

The Ministry of Tourism has revamped the Swadesh Darshan scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations in the country, following a destination and tourist centric approach and the Ministry has sanctioned 53 projects for Rs. 2207.08 crore under this scheme in the country. Further, Challenge Based Destination Development (CBDD) – a sub-scheme of Swadesh Darshan 2.0 has also been initiated in 4 categories viz. Ecotourism and Amrit Dharohar, Spiritual Tourism, Culture & Heritage and Vibrant Village Programme and the Ministry has sanctioned 37 projects for Rs. 687.99 crore under this initiative in the country.

The details of projects sanctioned by the Ministry under SD, SD2.0 and CBDD Schemes in the county including Tamil Nadu are annexed.
