TEXTILE PARKS IN TELANGANA

- (a) the details of textile parks and integrated textile projects approved in Telangana;
- (b) the details regarding Central assistance extended for handloom and powerloom sectors;
- (c) the details regarding measures taken to enhance exports from Telangana; and
- (d) whether any new textile clusters are under consideration?

(a): Ministry of Textiles is implementing two scheme namely Scheme for Integrated Textiles Park (SITP) & PM Mega Integrated Textile Regions and Apparel Park (PM MITRA) Scheme for establishing textile parks across various locations in the country including Telangana. Under the SITP Scheme; 2 textile parks have been established in Telangana. Furthermore, 1 Brownfield project has been sanctioned under the PMMITRA Park Scheme. This park has recently been inaugurated in May 2026. Currently with the grounded investment of Rs. 3862 cr, approximately 24,500 jobs have been generated. Details of these projects is as per **Annexure-A**.

(b) The Ministry of Textiles is implementing the following schemes to promote handloom sector and welfare of handloom workers across the country including Telangana:

1. National Handloom Development Programme;
2. Raw Material Supply Scheme;

Under the above schemes, financial assistance is provided to eligible handloom agencies/workers for raw materials, procurement of upgraded looms & accessories, solar lighting units, construction of workshed, skilling, product diversification & design innovation, technical and common infrastructure, publicity and brand development through India Handloom Brand (IHB), Handloom Mark (HLM) and GI tag, e-commerce facilities, marketing of handloom products in

domestic/overseas markets, concessional loans under weavers' MUDRA scheme and social security etc.

Further, on receipt of proposals from Government of Telangana, financial assistance of Rs.1223.97 lakh has been provided for 26 Small Cluster Development Programme (SCDPs) covering 4971 beneficiaries during the FY 2021-22 to 2025-26.

Further, the details regarding Central assistance extended for handloom and Powerloom sectors is as per **Annexure-B**.

(c) The Government has implemented various duty-exemption, duty-remission and export-promotion schemes for the benefit of all exporters, including those from Telangana. These include RoSCTL, RoDTEP, Advance Authorisation, EPCG, Duty Drawback and the Export Promotion Mission. Exporters also benefit from preferential market access under the 16 Free Trade Agreements currently in force, which helps reduce costs and improve export competitiveness.

Further, for export promotion of handlooms, financial assistance are provided for participation of handloom exporters/weavers from across the country in various International marketing events/fairs i.e International Trade Fair, Buyer Seller Meet, Reverse Buyer Seller Meet, Big Ticket events, Bharat Tex, are organized through Handloom Export Promotion Council (HEPC). In consultation with stakeholders, as part of the 'Textile Summit' organized by the Ministry, the Govt. of Telangana has formalized 'State Export Action Plan' to boost exports in the sector.

(d) The Government has announced an integrated program in the Union Budget 2026-27, featuring the **Textile Expansion and Employment Scheme** to modernise traditional clusters with capital support for machinery, technology upgradation and common testing and certification centres.
